Note 3: The Senate deadline for passing all bills and joint resolutions <i>does not</i> take into consideration the House deadline for passing Senate bills and joint resolutions. <i>Realistically</i> , to be eligible for consideration by the House under its end-of-session deadlines, Senate bills and joint resolutions must be passed by the Senate and received by the House <i>before</i> the 130th day.  Note 4: Both Senate and House rules require a 48-hour layout for a resolution suspending limitations on a conference committee considering the general appropriations bill, if such a resolution is necessary. Neither rule has an express deadline for considering that resolution, which should occur before consideration of the general appropriations bill.
